Raritan Headwaters Applies for Renewal of Land Trust Accreditation

Bedminster, **2/12/23** - The land trust accreditation program recognizes land conservation organizations that meet national quality standards for protecting important natural places and working lands forever. Raritan Headwaters is pleased to announce it is applying for renewal of accreditation. A public comment period is now open.

The Land Trust Accreditation Commission, an independent program of the Land Trust Alliance, conducts an extensive review of each applicant's policies and programs. "Accreditation demonstrates our commitment to permanent land conservation in the upper Raritan River watershed, and our accountability to local residents who support our mission," Cindy Ehrenclou, RHA's Executive Director.

The Commission invites public input and accepts signed, written comments on pending applications. Comments must relate to how Raritan Headwaters complies with national quality standards.
